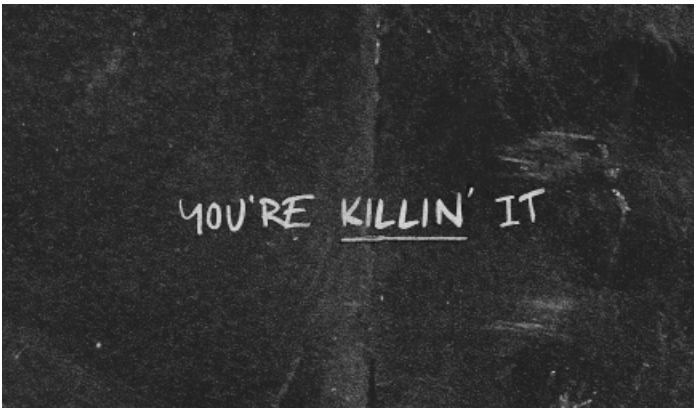




LH Groups exist to fulfill the mission of the church to Reach the Lost & Make Disciples. We do this primarily through Connecting People & Strengthening their Faith.

GROUP QUESTIONS

Big Idea: *You're Killin' It: As a follower of Jesus you're doing much better than you think you are, and you've come much further than you know. But what is it that keeps us from seeing it? More often than not it's the voices we value, the perspective we hold, and the strength we draw from.*

Recap or have someone read 1 Kings 18:22-40

Read 1 Kings 19:1-3

- What happened to Elijah between his great victory and fleeing for his life?
- Why do you think the voices we listen to have so much impact on us?
- What steps could you take to hear God's voice more clearly, and value His words more dearly?

Read 1 Kings 19:11-18

- What is Elijah's current perspective of the situation? How does this affect his attitude and choice?
- Why is perspective so important to how we act and react?
- Read Romans 8:28 - How does this verse help shift your perspective about what you're currently going through.

Read Psalm 73:26

- When have you experienced the strength of God at work in your life, versus operating in your own strength?
