- As you see God's commitment to Joshua, and understand that He has the same commitment towards you, how does this affect your perspective of God, yourself, and your situation?

- God's commands are not a burden to bear for Him but an invitation to a closer relationship with Him. What could you do to start approaching obedience as a relationship builder and not a begrudging obligation?
- If you truly believed all of God's promises towards you, how different would your confidence in Him be? How would this affect your every day life?
