Read Joshua 2:1-3

- What decision did Rahab have to make? Why would this have been difficult?
- When have you had a decision come to you that you weren't expecting?

Read Joshua 2:4-7 & 17-23

Some decisions in have the potential to change your entire life.

- In what ways could Rahab's life change with either decision?
- When have you been at a crossroads in life and how did you handle it?

Read Hebrews 11:29-31

Rahab went from a life of shame to a legacy of hope with one decision of faith. Faith is not a idea to believe in but an belief to act upon.

- How will you approach decisions differently now knowing the impact they can have on not just your own life but on the lives of those around you?
- What steps could you take to make decisions based on faith in God rather than immediate circumstance?
- Does it change your perspective about yourself, or about those around you, to know that no one is too far gone? In what ways?
