GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Haggai 2:10-14

God tells the people of Israel that contact with a clean thing does not make other things clean, but contact with a dirty thing will make other things dirty. What is the message God is trying to communicate to the Israelites?

Where have you seen this to be true in your own life?

God's desire is that we be holy just as He is holy. How did the Israelites view of how to become holy differ from God's way?

Read Isaiah 29:13

What does this say about God's desire for obedience?

Read Haggai 2:15-19

God's message continues with a declaration that He had not yet blessed them because the blessing of God follows obedience to God. On the surface it appeared the Israelites were obeying by building the temple but underneath their hearts were in the wrong place. How can we examine ourselves to see if our hearts are in the right place?

This message from God can feel a bit hopeless on the surface. Your good deeds can't clean up bad deeds, and bad deeds continue to corrupt good deeds. It can ring of the first half of Romans 6:23 that "The wages of sin is death...". But there is a second half to that verse. What does it say, and what does it mean for us?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:21

What does this mean for us?
