GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Luke 19:29-36

- Have you experienced Jesus to be approachable?

Read Luke 19:37-40

- What is significant about these verses?
- When did you discover that Jesus is worthy?

Read Luke 19:41-42

- Here Jesus cries over the God's people because they've once again missed that point right in front of them. What were they missing?
- We often settle for far less than what Jesus wants for us. When have you received more from Jesus than you could've imagined?
