ICEBREAKER

When's the last time someone served you or cared for you in a shocking or unexpected way?

GROUP QUESTIONS

Read John 13:1-6

- In that day and age the washing of feet was the job of the lowest of the servants. It was truly a dirty job. What does this act show us about Jesus?
- In verse 3 we get an interesting perspective of Jesus' mindset. His security in His identity and His destiny allowed Him to be free to put others above Himself. What mindset should we have when it comes to our relationship with others?
- If you could put yourself in that very room would you think to wash the others feet?

Read John 13:6-10

- Sometimes it's not the humility to serve that hinders us, but the humility to be served. How can you relate to Peter's reaction here?

Read John 13:10-11

- Consider the fact the Jesus washed Judas' feet, whom He knew was going to betray Him to death. How does this affect your view of who we should serve?

Read John 13:34-35

- In light of all of the previous verses, in what ways has your view of loving one another been affected?
- Love truly is an action and not merely a feeling. How could you actively love those who don't know Jesus better? How about those that do know Him?
