Week 3 - The Road to Suffering

ICEBREAKER

There are two kinds of suffering, the suffering that you did nothing to deserve, and the suffering that comes from doing something dumb or wrong. Share about a time that you suffered because of your own mistake.

GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Luke 22:39-46

- Jesus finds Himself in a situation where suffering has come for Him, completely undeserved. What stands out to you most about this passage?
- Jesus shows his full humanity here as He is shown to need strengthening, experience pain and anguish, and not wanting to suffer. How does this help you relate to Jesus?
- Despite His request to the Father to find a way around the suffering, both physically and spiritually, Jesus declares, 'yet I want Your will to be done, not mine'. What steps could you take in the midst of your own undeserved suffering to put the Father's will first?

Read 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

- To whom should we run when we suffer? How would you run to Him?
- How do these verses encourage you in the midst of your own suffering?

Read Hebrews 4:14-16

- What amazes you about verse 15?
- How do we suffer well as life comes our way unexpectedly and sometimes undeservedly?
