# **GROUP QUESTIONS**

#### Read John 18:28-35

- What was the crime the Jews were accusing Jesus of committing?
- Pilate doesn't seem to want to get involved in the issue. Even in his first question to Jesus, 'Are you the king of the Jews?' he stays on the surface. But Jesus makes it personal by asking him what he thinks. When has Jesus helped you take truth from merely public to being more personal?

### Read John 18:36-38

- What does Jesus mean by 'My kingdom is not of this world'?
- Jesus is the only person who can say He came into the world, as He is the only one who chose to come. What does it mean that He came to testify to the truth?
- Pilate's famous question, 'What is truth?' is a perfect picture of how Jesus challenges us to reevaluate all that we know in light of who He is. When in your life have you had to reevaluate what you thought you know because Jesus challenged you?

#### Read John 14:6

- What does it mean to you that Jesus is the way? What about that He is the truth? How about the life?
- The Jews wanted the Messiah to be a political hero, and to save them from the Romans, we often want Jesus to be our own type of hero from our own version of captivity, but Jesus doesn't compromise to our preference but rather offers a greater solution. What is that solution and how do we receive it?
