GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Hebrews 10:24-25

- Who in your life has offered this kind of encouragement to you?
- Why is this so important?

Pastor Sammy summed it up by saying "Godly Inspiration Requires Collaboration, Which Cannot Happen In Isolation"

- Share of a time that you received inspiration from God because of a relational collaboration.

Read 1 Samuel 14:1-15

- Who do you relate with more in this story, Jonathan or the armor-bearer? Explain.
- When have you seen the benefit of having your mentality challenged, or challenging the mentality of a friend? What were the benefits?
- Do you have people in your life who support you wholeheartedly? How do they show their support? What could you do to be someone who supports their friends wholeheartedly?

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

- According to Solomon, why is friendship such a good strategy?
- Is exercising your faith easier or harder when you are doing it side by side with a friend? Why?

Read Hebrews 10:24-25 again

- What does it mean to spur someone on to love and good deeds or as Pastor Sammy put it, Propel them Supernaturally? How can we be better at receiving our friends attempts to propel us, and how can we be better at propelling others?
