GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Proverbs 18:21 & James 1:19-20

- Why do you think words possess so much power?
- What has been the impact on your life from those who have spoken words of life? What about words of death?
- How have you seen your own words impact someone elses life?
- Why should we be slow to speak?

Pastor John posed 3 questions to help us slow down and think before we speak.

- Which of these do you think would help you the most in having more control over your words?
 - 1. Does It Need To Be Said? (Proverbs 10:19 & Proverbs 17:9)
 - 2. How Will I Say It? (Colossians 4:6)
 - 3. What's The Win? (James 3:2)

Read Colossians 4:6

Pastor John also offered 3 ways to season your words.

- Which one of these tends to be your most "seasonless" area?
- How would you use each of these in your effort to season your spoken word, texts, social-media comments, emails, etc.?
 - 1. Don't Assume You Have All The Facts. (Proverbs 18:17)
 - 2. Respect The Relationship.
 - 3. Control Your Emotions. (Proverbs 25:15)
- What others might you add?
- What does it mean to make sure our conversation is 'full of grace'?
