GROUP QUESTIONS

- What do you think it will be like to live by sight?

Read John 11:25-26

- Death is not a pleasant subject for most, but it is a relevant subject for all. What does Jesus mean by His statement here and how does it change your approach to life?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:9-10

- What do you feel or think of when you hear that we will all stand before God's judgement and give account for all that we've done, good and bad?
- How can you begin to embrace this 'fear of the Lord'?
- What is our ultimate purpose in this life and in the life to come? In what ways can you live this out now?
