End of the World As We Know It Week 2 - Different or Indifferent?

GROUP QUESTIONS

Have you ever taken a bite or a sip of something and immediately spit it out? What was it and why did it not meet your expectation?

Read Revelation 3:14-22

- In verse 14, Jesus is identified by serveral names and characteristics. Which one stands out to you the most?
- What goes through your mind when you dwell on the idea that Jesus knows all of our deeds?

Ask each group member to take a moment to assess their own spiritual temperature, whether they are hot, cold or lukewarm. This is a rhetorical exercise, and does not require a response.

Some of the contributing factors to being lukewarm are the Illusion of Self-Sufficiency and the Distractions of the World.

- How do you tend to view your life and spiritual situation in light of verse 17?
- Jesus promises Himself as the solution to our problems. How have you experienced this to be true in your own life?
- What are the things in your life that you see, experience, or participate in that stir your affections for Jesus? What are the things the deaden your affections for Him?

Pastor Sammy lists several symptoms of being lukewarm.

- We're More Concerned With Impressing People Than Living For God.
- 2. We're Obsessed With Life On Earth Rather Than Eternity.
- 3. We Rationalize Sin And Live Without Truly Fearing
- 4. We Believe In Jesus, But We Rarely Share Our Faith.
- 5. We Only Turn To God When We Need Him.
- 6. We're Not Much Different From The World.
- Which one do you struggle with the most?
- Which one is not a struggle for you?
- What does it look like to repent?
- What is something you could do that requires faith?
