God of Revival Week 1- Ready for Revival

GROUP QUESTIONS

What do you think of when you hear the term 'revival'?

Pastor John talked about the secular myth, which is the misconception that the peak of Christianity was long ago in the past and it's been a steep decline ever since, and we're living in the lowest point in history. The reality is that it has been much less a slow steady decline and much more like the ebb and flow of a tide.

- How have you perceived the state of Christianity? Does this challenge or enhance your view of it?
- What idols have you seen exposed in your own life or in the world around you lately? Don't forget idols are not just things you enjoy, but things that you allow to control you, including fear.

We would likely all agree that the state of our world and immediate culture is ebbing in turmoil and disarray, and while this can be unsettling at times, it is also an opportunity for the flow of Jesus to come rushing in with revival. There are 3 things Pastor John stated God is looking for when it comes to the flow of revival.

God is looking for people who are willing. Read 2 Chronicles 16:9

- What does it look like to be willing to follow God where ever and however He might call? Does that idea make you hesitate?
- What might you need to add or take away in your daily life to have you heart fully willing to be used by God?

God is looking for people who are clear. Read 1 Corinthians 2:2 & 1 Corinthians 15:1-5

- Are you clear about what the gospel is and how it provides hope in every situation?
- How have you seen the gospel get muddied or modified?

God is looking for people who are desperate. Read Jeremiah 29:13

- What does a desperation for God look like?
- Desperation for God and faith in God are two very closely linked ideas. How can we allow our desperation for Him drive our faith in Him, and vice versa?
