Week 4 - Service

GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 20:20-28

- What does Jesus teach us about service here?
- How does that go against the culture we live in?

Jesus does not call us to something that He does not show us how to do. Pastor DT reminded us that we should never consider ourselves higher than Jesus, but should seek to follow His example.

Read John 13:12-17

- Jesus asks His disciples "Do you understand what I have done for you?". Do we understand what He did?
- What is Jesus referring to when He says we will be blessed if we do them?

Service Produces Humility

- What can we do to take steps towards true humility?

Read Philippians 2:5-9

- What would it look like to have the mindset of Christ in our relationships with those closest to us?
- What about strangers?

Read Matthew 6:1-6

- This all comes down to motivation. Do we serve others for recognition, or do we serve others out of a love for God and a love for the person?

Service Produces Freedom

Read Galatians 5:13-14

- Do you feel free when you put yourself first?
- Have you experienced the freedom of serving others with the same love you have for yourself?

Read Matthew 20:11-12

- Service ultimately shifts our perspective, position, and posture towards how Jesus calls us to live. What practical things could you do to start implementing the discipline of Service?
