



Week 1 - Go Up

GROUP QUESTIONS

Have you ever had a 'mountain top' experience? What happened?

Read Matthew 17:1-9

- Why did Jesus take Peter, James, and John up onto the mountain?
- What did they witness up there?
- Why does Jesus invite us to 'Go Up' with Him?
- God the Father speaks a declaration about Jesus, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!" What was the disciples reaction to this? What is your reaction?
- Why do you think the disciples fell down, terrified? Why is this an appropriate reaction?
- Is your awe for Jesus, and your willingness to listen to Him still as strong as it once was, or has it faded over time? What has gotten stronger or weaker, and what steps could you take to be growing in wonder and obedience?

Read Isaiah 43:19

- Do you see God at work preparing to do a new thing in your own life or the community around you?
- The mountain top is meant to give us a clear view of Jesus and a renewed perspective of the world around us. What shifts could you make in your approach to the world around you to view it more hopefully and missionally as 'new ways' are being made in the wilderness and 'new streams' are springing up in the wasteland?
