GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Acts 1:1-8

- Jesus has just returned from the dead and spent 40 days with His disciples teaching them about the Kingdom of God. What is their first question to Him? What does this reveal about their thinking?
- How does Jesus respond? Why is His redirection important?
- What is implied in being a witness of Jesus?

An Unshakable Peace

Read John 16:33 & Romans 15:13 & Philippians 4:4-7

- It has often been said that peace is not the absence of conflict. How does the peace of Jesus make us unshakable?
- Where does this peace come from and how do we maintain it? How do we share it? **An Unshakable Peace**

An Unmistakable Presence

Read 1 Peter 2:17 & 2 Timothy 2:24-26

- What should our presence convey to the world around us?
- Does your presence in your family, workplace or community line up with what Scripture teaches? If not, what steps could we take to change our presence?

An Unleashed Potential

Read 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

- If our victories in the valley are not won by our own wisdom or words, but with Gods power, than what kind of potential do we have? Why do we often still hesitate to enter the valley and walk out our calling?
- Where do you believe God is calling you to start walking into the valley with Him?
