GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 24:36-50

- What comfort should we take from the idea that no one knows the day or the hour but God?
- How should that same idea spur us to action?
- While Jesus is certainly providing landmarks of what will come before the Day of the Lord, his focus is on reminding us that the turmoil and chaos that comes will not deter the gospel from being preached. In other words, as the world grows darkened, the gospel grows brighter. What ways can we shine the gospel into the darkness?

Read Matthew 28:18-20

- These are Jesus' last words before ascending into heaven. What is His instruction to His disciples?
- What does it mean to make disciples? How can you start making disciples?
- What holds you back from following this command?
- Jesus offers one of the most comforting statements in all of the Bible in the last verse. What does this mean to you personally?
