GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Psalm 23:1-6

We saw last week that Jesus promised to guide, refresh and provide for us. In light of that what stands out to you about verses 4-6?

The implication is that Jesus leads us through the valley as part of leading us on the right paths, and that we are never alone. When have you experienced Jesus leading you through valley, while never letting go of you?

Read Psalm 119:48-50

Jesus promises to comfort us in the midst of the valley. How does He comfort us according to these verses?

What means has He used to comfort you? What promises do you take comfort in?

Read Psalm 23:5-6

What hope do these verses give you?

Read Psalm 139:7-10

What are your thoughts on these verses?
