### **GROUP QUESTIONS**

#### **Read Luke 1:5-20**

What stands out to you about this story?

Timing is everything, when have you experienced God's timing being better than your own?

Our waiting is never wasted. We see this in how God is always working on us, working on others, or working in ways we don't even know about. What can we do in the midst of waiting on God to have this perspective?

#### Read Isaiah 40:29-31

Our waiting isn't weakness, how can we receive strength in the midst of waiting? What does this kind of waiting look like?

#### Read Luke 1:14-17

We can be confident that our waiting will be rewarded, what was Zechariah and Elizabeth's reward? How does their reward help the perspective of our reward in waiting?

Zechariah and Elizabeth's names combine to mean God Remembers God's Promise. From the following list of God's Promises which ones bring you the most comfort and why?
