## LH Kids FAQ

#### What time do doors open?

The building will open at 8:30am. All guests will need to enter through the front of the building in order to display their printed or digital Eventbrite ticket to check-in. The LH Kids doors will open for drop-off 15 minutes prior to the service beginning.

# Will LH Kids be available during the Gathering?

Yes, we will begin offering LH Kids at the 9AM SERVICE on Dec. 6th for 2ND TO 5TH GRADE ONLY. We LOVE kids at LH, and it's our goal to always provide a Jesus centered experience and an excellent level of care for your child while they are with us. This is why we are opening LH Kids in phases beginning with the older grades. We know how important it is to disciple these little ones, which is why we will continue to provide LH Kids Online for you to watch as a family at home! ## When will younger grades be open?

We will open up more grades and classrooms as we feel it's safe and we're able to do so. We can't do LH Kids without the support of our AMAZING leaders! #### Does registering guarantee my child a spot in LH Kids?

Yes, registering your child for LH Kids through Eventbrite is the only way to guarantee a spot. There will be a limited number of spots open each week per grade so we recommend registering early in the week.

#### Does my child need to wear a mask?

Masks will be required for children kindergarten and up. Preschoolers (3-5 year olds) will not be required to wear a mask, however, we do encourage it.

#### How will classrooms, toys, and supplies be sanitized?

Classrooms will be cleaned and fogged with an EPA approved, child-safe coronavirus disinfectant before and after each service. Toys and supplies will be cleaned during the week with the same disinfectant.

# Will children be physically distanced from each other?

We will do our best to keep children's hands and feet to themselves while in our care; however, we can't promise they will remain at a 6 ft distance at all times. We will be reducing our capacity to 50% in order for kids to have the ability to distance themselves.

# I do not feel comfortable having my child gather with a group of children yet, OR my kids are younger than 2nd-5th grade, but I would like to gather with a few people. What can I do?

We understand there may be families not ready to come back, OR families that are ready to return; however, LH Kids isn't open to their child's ages yet. We are also encouraging in-home watch parties! These are gatherings of 10 people or less who meet at an individual's home to watch the online service. These can happen anywhere at any time! And we even have <u>ACTIVITY GUIDES</u> just for families to have a little fun and continue the conversation after the service.
