

Photographer / Videographer Job Description

General Description

In support of the Project Director (PD) and in cooperation with the Arts Team, the Photographer / Videographer visually tells the story of what God is doing through Lighthouse Church (LH). As a multimedia creative, the Photographer / Videographer will use their integrated skill set to both bring creative vision to life and to support our mission to reach the lost and make disciples. This includes, but is not limited to: producing videos, short films, and photography assets for use in In-Person and Online Worship Services, Special Events, Social Media, Website Content, Communications, and LH Store / LH Merchandise, as well as providing ministry-specific or church-wide initiative support, from concept to fully edited deliverables.

Essential Job Functions

1. Collaborate with PD and Arts Department to develop concept pitches and relevant, innovative, engaging content for sermon series, ministry initiatives, and other projects through photography and videography assets.
2. Support teaching pastor team through the creation and production of photography and videography assets that document and/or enhance worship and teaching experiences.
3. Create bump videos and one-off films for worship experiences and special events.
4. Produce photographs and video clips to maximize impact and effectiveness across all communication channels, including but not limited to, the LH Website and social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube. Process, Edit and Prep files. Package digital files for outside vendors as needed.
5. Photograph LH Merch, including modeled apparel, for the LH Store on a quarterly basis.
6. Support the Studio & Production teams on a project-by-project basis to create compelling, storied videos to communicate what God is doing at LH.
7. Adhere to and champion the LH Brand Guidelines and LH Photography Guidelines, while consistently developing skills and identifying new creative techniques and cutting edge photography / videography trends. Maintain an organized storage and inventory of both digital and physical assets, equipment and supplies. Oversee maintenance, repair and replacement of photography equipment.
8. Lead, Build, Manage & Train a team of volunteer photographers and videographers to assist in capturing the life and life change that happens at Lighthouse.Church.
9. Perform other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience

The ideal candidate is an LH partner with 3-5 years experience as a Photographer / Videographer in a church, non-profit, and/or business environment. A degree in photography/videography, cinematography/film, multimedia or related field is desired. Extensive demonstrated experience, in some cases, may be substituted. The successful individual will have strong attention to detail, exceptional communication skills, and the ability to meet deadlines in a fast-paced environment. He or she will also possess a working knowledge of Lightroom, Adobe Photoshop / Creative Cloud, and Frame.io, as well as Google and Apple applications. A portfolio with examples of video and photographic media is required.
